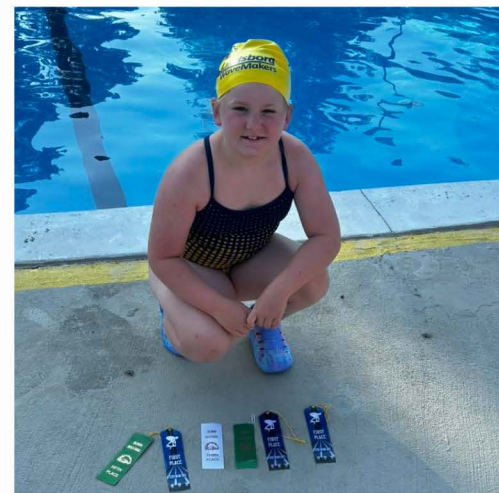

reduced/free lunch scholarships

Lindsborg Recreation is pleased to offer scholarship opportunities based on the following policy: Those on free and reduced-price lunches through USD 400 are eligible for a 50 percent scholarship on select programs. There is a \$75 child limit per fiscal year. Our fiscal year runs July 1 through June 30 of the following year. No scholarships will be offered on pool passes or other events as stated.

ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR ALL PROGRAMS

Go to lindsborgrec.org

1. Click on Account / Register tab.
2. Log into your account or click "Create a new Account". Fill out the Personal Details form for you (the account holder).
3. Once logged in, Click Add New Participant and add all people you plan to register for programs. Add each participant separately.
4. Once participants are added you can click the red Program Registration button and register each person for the program they are interested in.
5. Check out and pay online once all programs have been added to your cart.

refunds

1. A full refund will be issued in the event of a class cancellation due to insufficient enrollment. We will make every effort to ensure that every participant is informed of the cancellation.
2. Refunds will be available up to 48 hours prior to the first class meeting. A \$5.00 processing fee will be deducted, along with the amount of supplies and/or t-shirts that have been ordered. After the class has started or before the midway point, you will only be refunded 50% of the class cost. After the midway point, a refund will not be issued.
3. Waiting lists will be formed when classes have met the maximum number of participants. Every attempt will be made to accommodate participants.
4. Refunds will be issued by refunding your credit card that was used to pay for the class or a credit will be placed on your online account.
5. It is the policy of the LRD to refund 80% of the unused portion of the program fee due to medical reasons or moving from McPherson County.

We will apply late fees to all late sign-ups, if openings remain. Youth activities and Sports will be charged a non-refundable \$10.00 late fee after the registration deadline. There will be a late registration date that no sign ups will be taken after.

what swim level are you?

Level 1-white:

Introductory to Water Safety and Skill (Trust and Submersion): This is my child's first time taking swim lessons or took them last year but still does not feel comfortable getting into the water. They are nervous, but excited to grow and learn the importance of water safety and training.

Level 2-red:

Fundamental Swimming (Passed Level White): My child has been to swimming lessons before or feels comfortable getting in the water alone. Swimmer should be able to put head under water and float on front and back with support.

Level 3-yellow:

Swimming Strokes (Passed Level Red): Swimmer is comfortable being in the water alone, is able to go under and float. Swimmer is ready to learn basic strokes for forward movement and direction change.

Level 4-blue/green:

Stroke Improvement and Refinement (Passed Level Yellow): Swimmer knows how to swim. Swimmer will learn perfecting their strokes, alternate breathing, flip turns, treading water, and different types of dives.

youth sport & program policies

The LRD will set registration periods for each sport, allowing enough time in advance for individuals to register before deadlines.

All activity registrations will be based on either age or grade, depending on the sport. The age cutoff date will vary for each sport.

Documentation for proof of age and grade level may be requested at any time.

Deadlines will be strictly enforced to ensure management efficiency, safety and quality of the programs.

No TEAM registrations! LRD only accepts individual registrations on a first come first serve basis.

There will be NO Coach or Friend Requests allowed. This is not allowed due to the volume of requests and the LRD commitment to having each team BALANCED as much as possible.

If there are not enough numbers for certain age groups, the LRD may choose to combine age groups. Leagues may be combined based on a 2-year differential to en-sure safety and quality of programs.

Participants must play in their appropriate age/grade level. LRD staff has the final say if a participant plays in a different age division.

The LRD cannot guarantee a program will run until registration has ended and participant levels have been determined. Based on registration numbers, participants may not be able to participate in the program in which they are registered for.

After the registration deadline, late registrations will be taken only if there are spots available. If the program is full, a wait list will be kept and the first person on the wait list will be called if a roster spot becomes available. All late registrations will have a \$10 fee added to them.

For all Itty-Bitty Sport Programs, late registrations will not be taken after the program start date.

Uniforms for any late registration may not be delivered by the first game.

Program fees are subject to change.
